

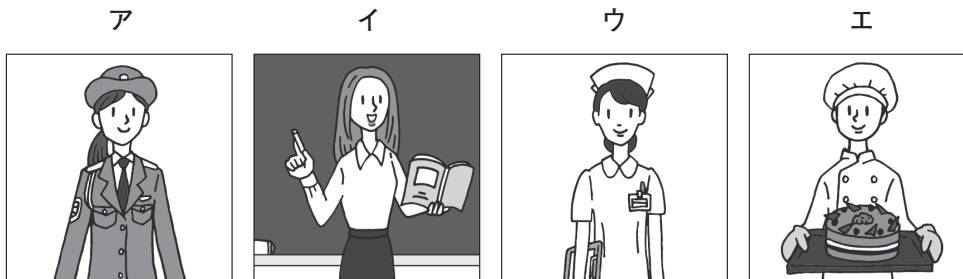

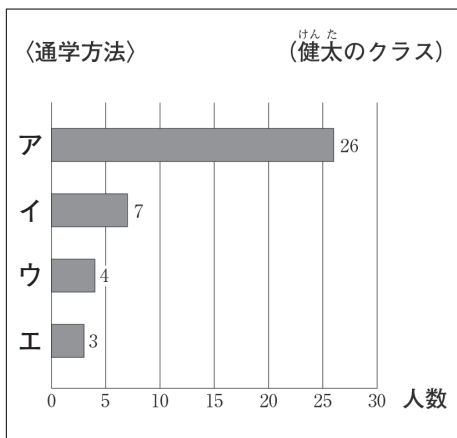

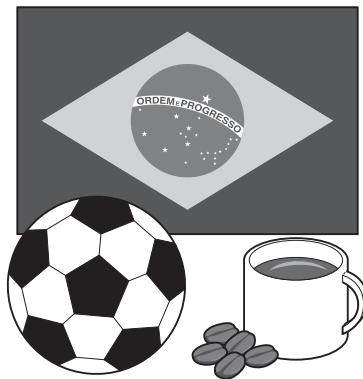

V 田中先生とスコット先生が、服を買うときに重視することに関するアンケートの結果を見せながら、授業で生徒たちと話をしています。次の英文を読んで、あとの問いに答えなさい。

*Mr. Tanaka:* What's important to you when you buy clothes? Today I'll show you the result\* of the survey.\* Look at ①this graph. Quality\* comes in first. Design comes next. What's important to you, Haruto?

*Haruto:* Price. I want many options\* when I choose what to wear every day, so I always want to buy many cheap clothes, instead of\* just a few expensive ones.

*Mr. Tanaka:* I see. More than half of the people answered "Price." How about you, Chika?

*Chika:* I often go shopping with my mother, and we both try to buy clothes that will last\* a long time.

*Ms. Scott:* How do you know about it, Chika?

*Chika:* Well, for example, we can look at the tag\* to see what they are made of. Clothes made of nice material\* will last longer than those made of cheap material that may stretch\* more easily. It is often expensive, but we think the value\* is higher. It lasts for a longer time, so ②we won't need to buy ( ) ones.

*Kenta:* I'm happy to hear that. My father makes suits by hand in his shop.

*Chika:* Really? I will tell my father about it. He is thinking about buying a new suit for my sister's wedding this summer.

*Kenta:* Thank you, Chika. He tries to make really good suits for the people who wear them in his shop.

*Ms. Scott:* How nice! When I go to big stores and shopping malls, I never know the people who make the clothes. I feel better if I know where the things I wear came from. What do you think, Mr. Tanaka?

*Mr. Tanaka:* I think so, too. I often buy my clothes from small shops instead of the big stores. I know the owners, and I can trust them. How about everyone else?

*Haruto:* I agree with you, and I think buying products with good quality is sometimes important. But I don't want to spend all of my money on clothes.

*Ms. Scott:* I know many young people don't have a lot of money, so they can't buy high quality items. I don't think cheap products are always bad, but brand products usually have high quality.

*Mr. Tanaka:* That's right. We should think about which clothes we wear, and where they come from. When I buy new clothes, I think about these things, too. Look at the graph again. Only 25% of the people answered "Brand."

*Ms. Scott:* I can't believe it.

*Mr. Tanaka:* You're right. Brand image is very powerful.

*Naoko:* Yes. My mother cares about brands, too. She often tells me to choose the good brands. She says that the clothes I wear show what kind of person I am.

*Mr. Tanaka:* Your mother makes a good point. The clothes we wear can say a lot about us. I hope everyone will think about all these things when they go shopping next time.
